

The Big Event Tallahassee Community Service Site Guidelines
The Little Event 2026

I. I understand The Little Event is a one-day volunteer service project occurring on October 10th, 2026.

II. The Little Event is expected to last no more than 4 hours, and due to these time constraints, the entirety of my requested tasks may not be finished.

III. In the case of rain or other inclement weather on the day of The Little Event, I understand that The Big Event Tallahassee cannot guarantee the completion of my requested job.

IV. I understand all jobs that are able to be performed will be, but due to insurance and time constraints, The Big Event Tallahassee is unable to reschedule any requested jobs for a later date.

V. I understand that only the jobs listed on the Service Site Application will be completed, and Participants are not required to complete any jobs not listed.

VI. I understand that under no circumstances are The Big Event Tallahassee volunteers allowed to use any dangerous instrumentalities, including but not limited to power tools, mechanized equipment, or harsh chemicals (such as lawnmowers, weed eaters, pressure washers, paint stripper, etc.). I further agree to refrain from using them around the volunteer(s) during the project.

VII. I understand that The Big Event Tallahassee reserves the right to terminate any job at any time for any reason without prior notice.

VIII. I understand that I, as the job recipient, have the right to terminate volunteer services. If I would like to cancel my job, I must do so by September 25th, 2026. To cancel please contact The Big Event Tallahassee's Executive Directors at thebigevent.director@gmail.com

IX. I understand and agree that The Big Event Tallahassee and Florida State University are not responsible for the actions of the volunteers. As such, I agree to forever release, waive, discharge, and hold harmless The Big Event Tallahassee, the Florida State University Board of Trustees, Florida State University, and its officers and employees, from any and all suits, liability, claims and/or loss, whether caused by negligence or otherwise, arising from or associated with the actions of the volunteers or for any damages or restitution caused by individual volunteers. I understand this waiver includes any suits, liability, claims, or demands based on negligence, action, or inaction on the part of these parties.

XI. I understand that a staff member/resident must be physically present to provide guidance and suggestions at all times while volunteer participants are present and performing the job on October 10th, 2026.

XII. The Big Event Tallahassee is committed to a policy of non-discrimination for any member of the University's community on the basis of race, creed, color, sex, religion, national origin, age, disability, genetic information, veterans' status, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, or any other legally protected group status. This policy applies to faculty, staff, students,
